

Population Health Promotion: An International Perspective

Overview

This course focuses on social determinants of health including attention to theoretical influences and methodological approaches. Conceptual and methodological strengths and challenges will be considered with a view to develop critical interpretive skills in analysis of data sets and research reports and developing knowledge translation skills. This course will be concerned with the contributing factors to the health of the population as an aggregate. Population health status as a function of social, economic and physical environment, personal health practices, individual capacity and coping skills and healthcare services will be addressed. The influence of these factors and their interactive effect on societal health status will be considered. Further, the role of population health interventions in addressing health disparities will be examined from the stage of conception to evaluation. Important components such as community-engagement, partnership, policy and advocacy will also be highlighted.

Dr. Shanthi Johnson, Professor and Former Associate Dean at the Faculty of Kinesiology and Health Studies, University of Regina, Canada. Dr. Johnson has secured \$10.7 million in research grants, delivered over 300 presentations, published in prestigious journals such as the Lancet and served on many international grant adjudicating panels.
